

## PRESENTATION OF THE BIBLIOMINES PROJECT DURING THE INTERSESSIONAL MEETINGS IN JUNE 2008

“Bibliomines” is a project jointly conducted by the national mine action centres of Senegal (CNAMS) and Mauritania (PNDHD), the mine action training centre of Benin (CPADD) and the GICHD. This francophone online library will gather all documents about mine action and ERW which exist in French.

This project responds to a need frequently expressed by mine action stakeholders working in French-speaking mine-affected countries: to have better access to documents in French. Most documents are in English, and those existing in French are not well known and hard to access.

The database and the website are currently under construction. A first presentation of the project to French speaking actors took place in June during the Intersessional meetings of the APMBC.



For 2008, the project is financed by Switzerland (FDFA), Canada (CIDA) and France (CNEMA). The Bibliomines project was also selected for funding by the “Fonds francophone des Inforoutes”, a specific fund of the “Organisation internationale de la Francophonie”.
