



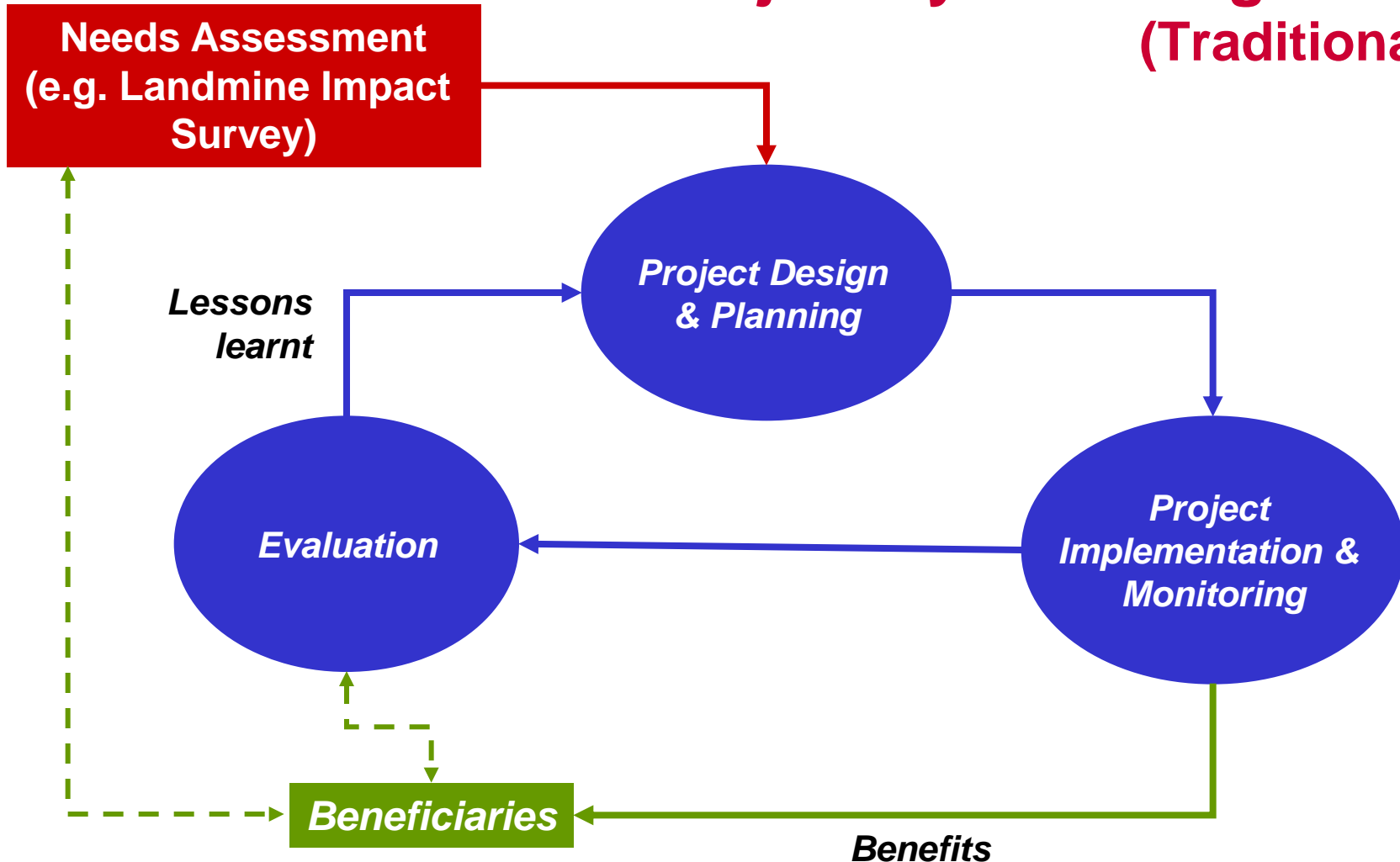

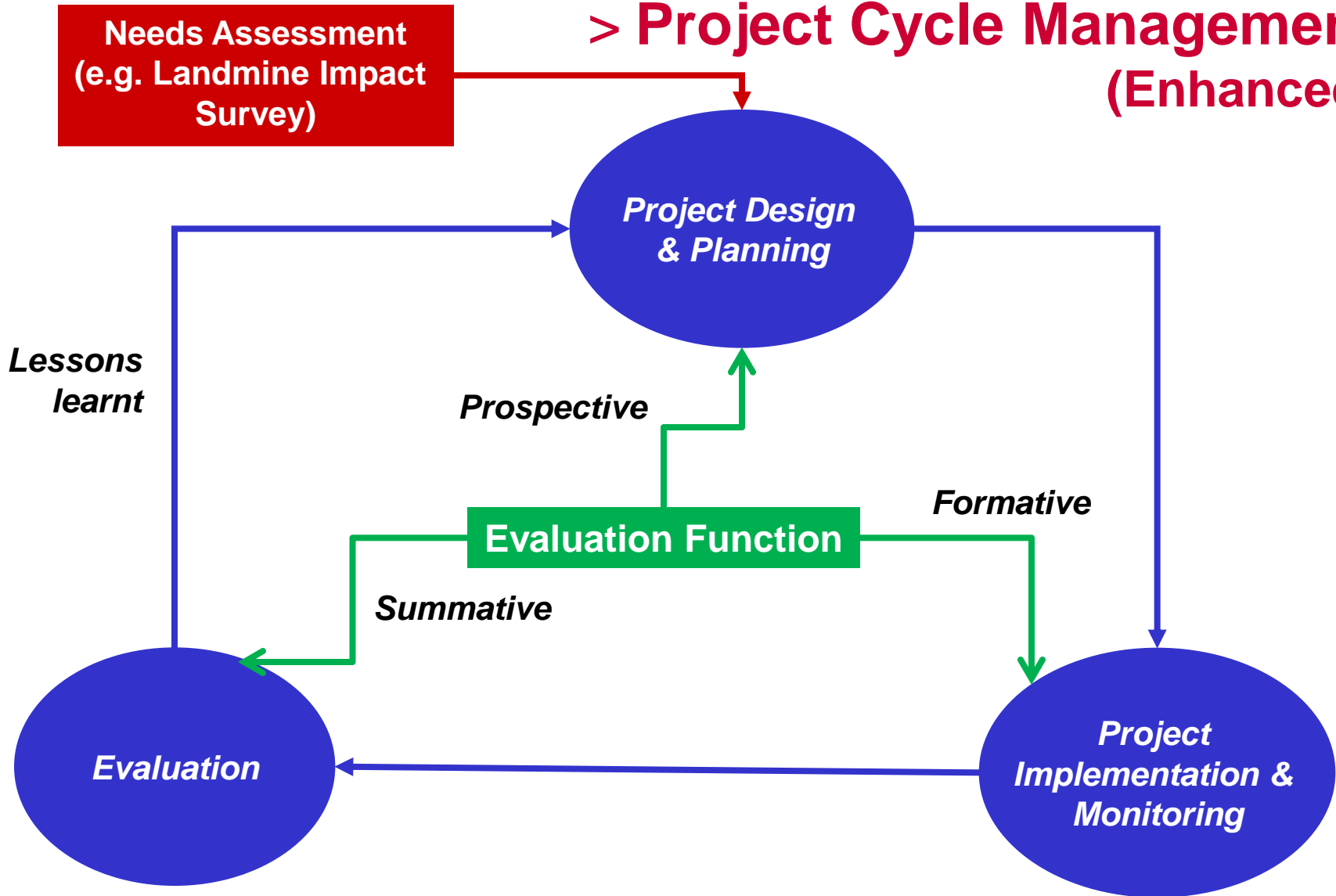

## > Project Cycle Management (Traditional)



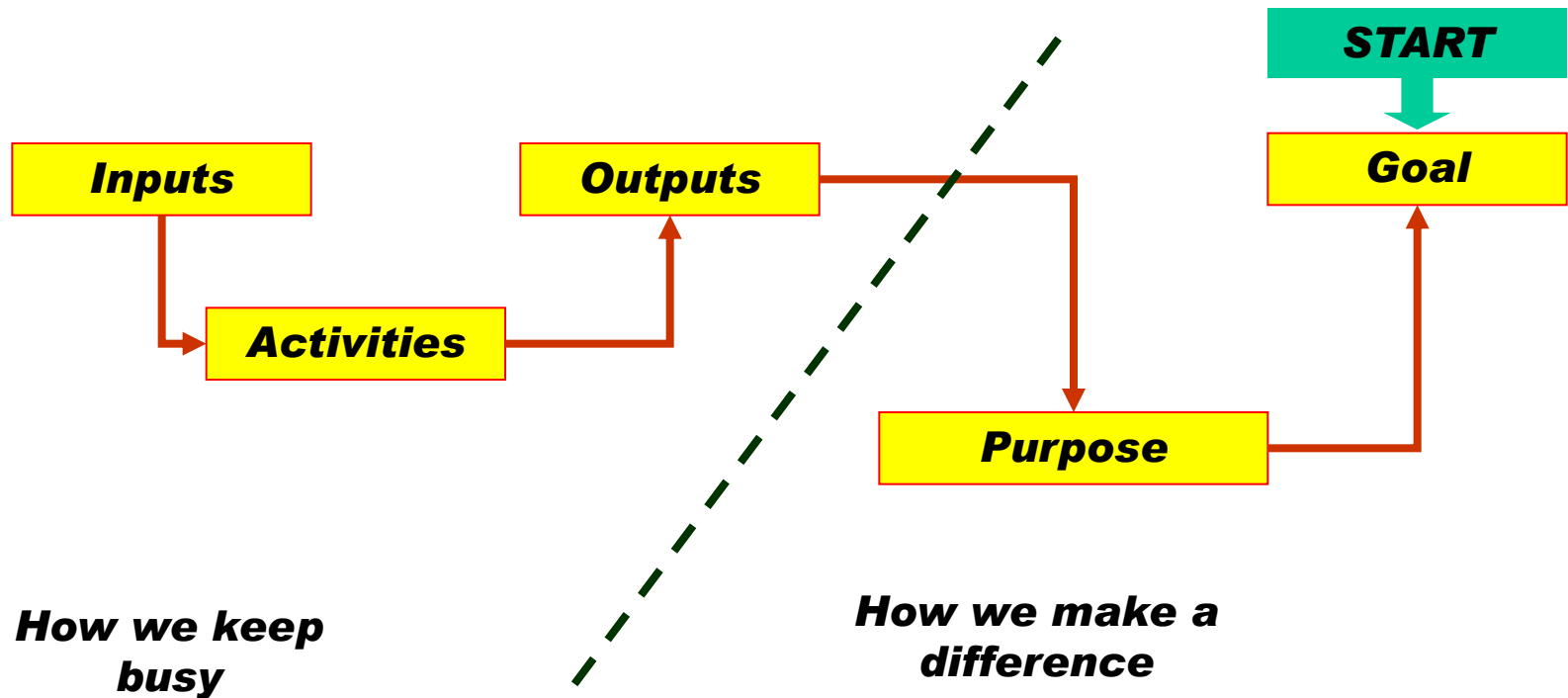
# > Project Cycle Management (Enhanced)





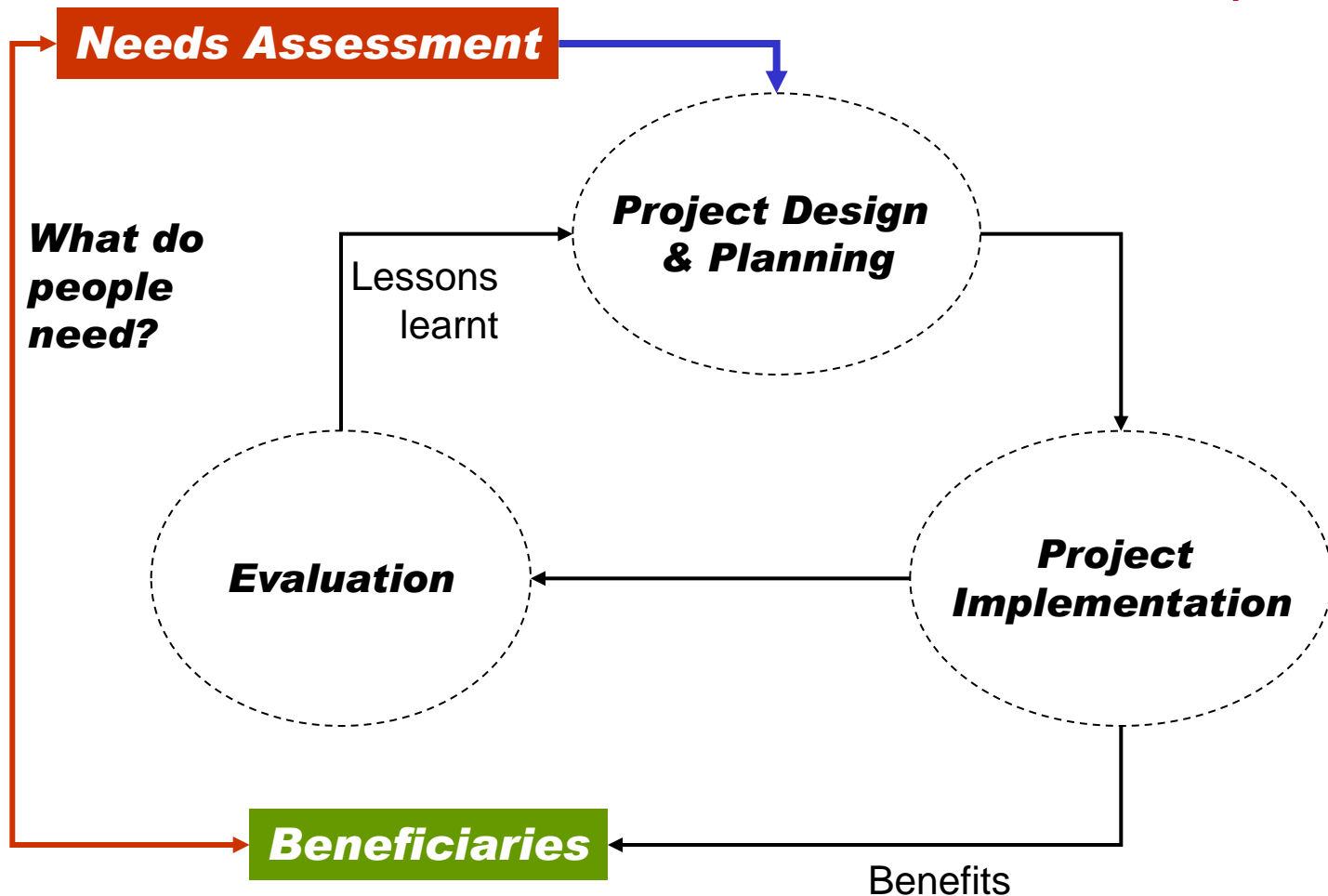
## > Core Planning Concept

- > Plan to make a difference by addressing people's needs rather than how to keep busy.



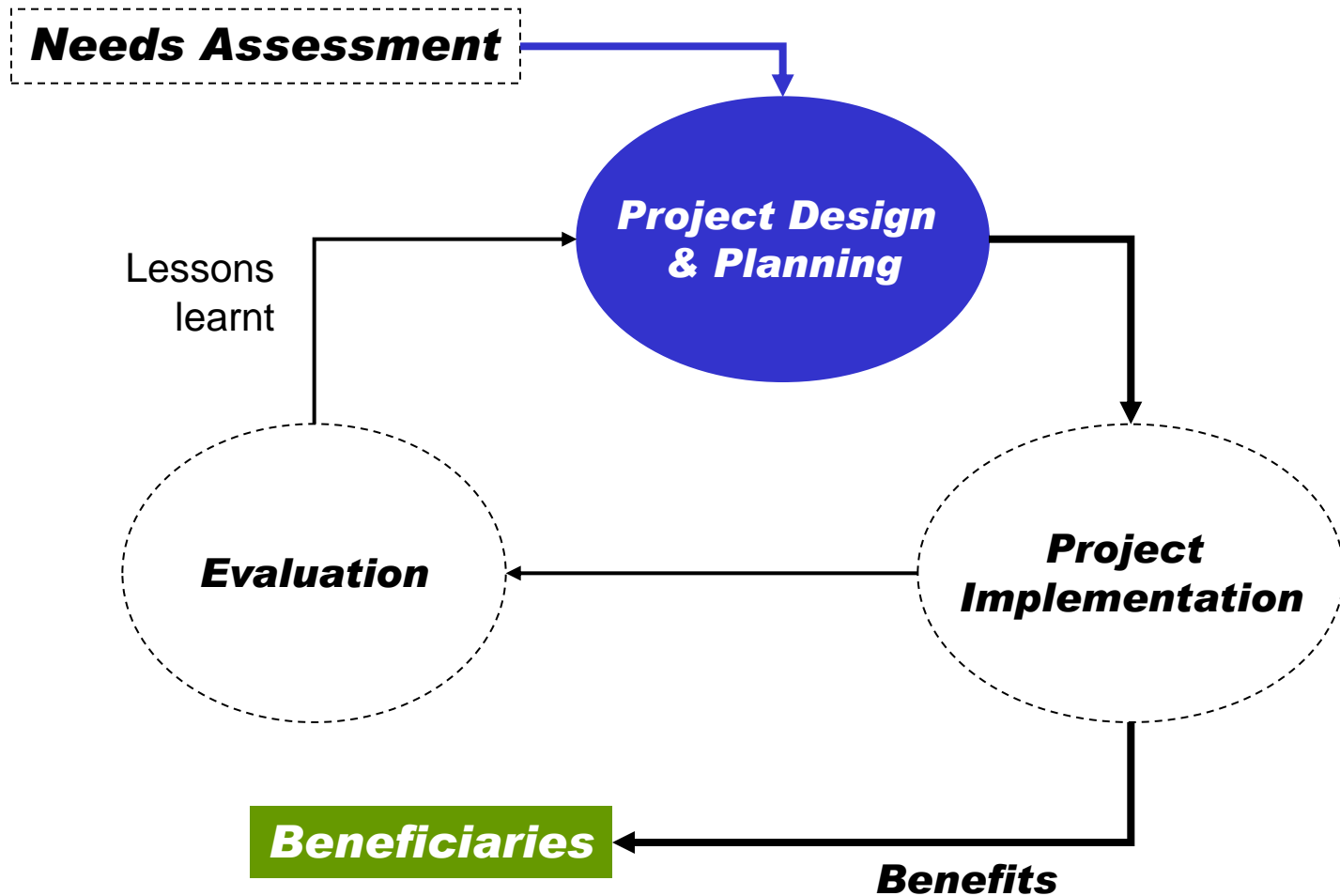


- > Start with an understanding of people's needs (needs assessment).



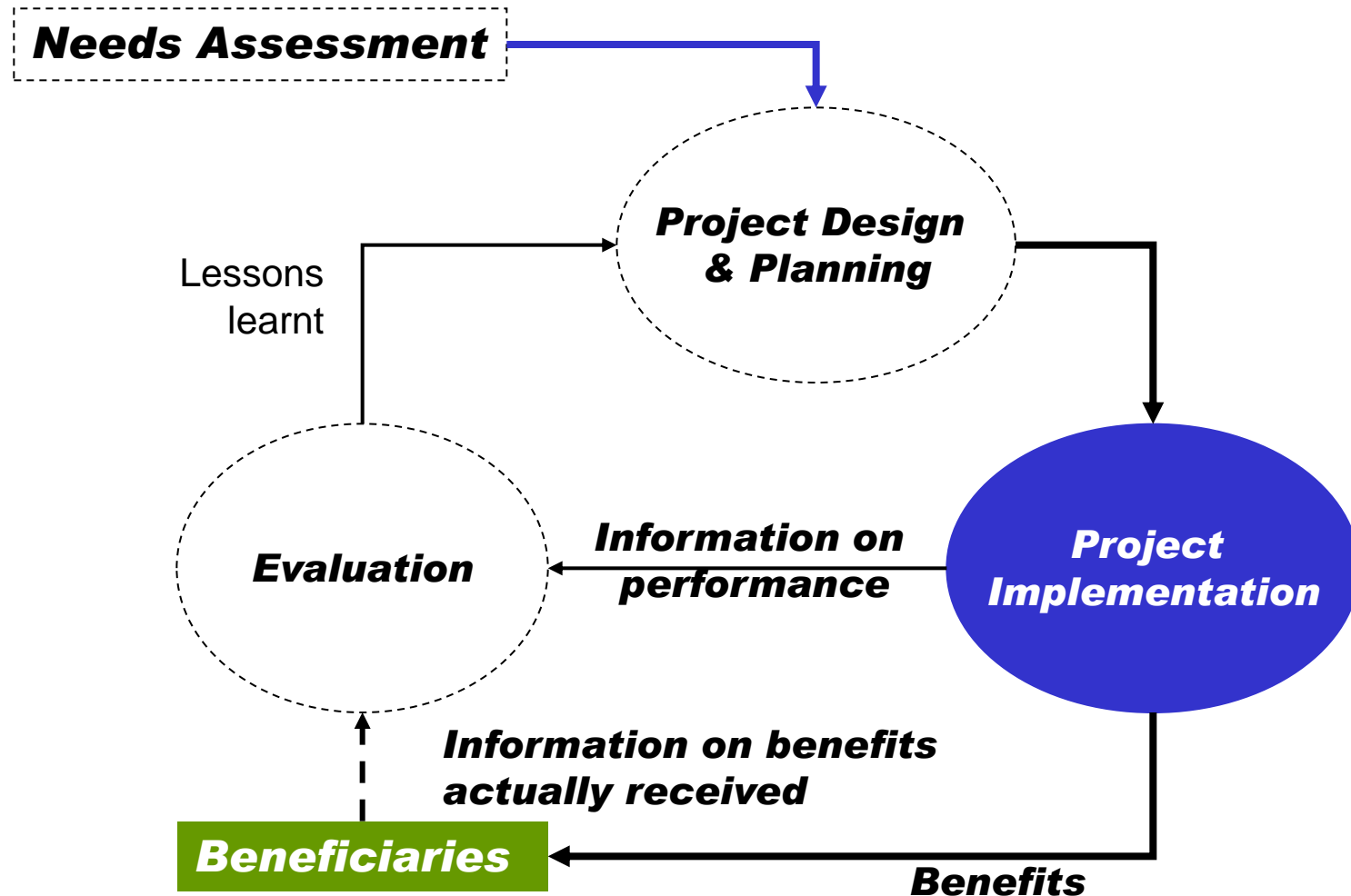


## > Design Projects to Provided the Needed Benefits



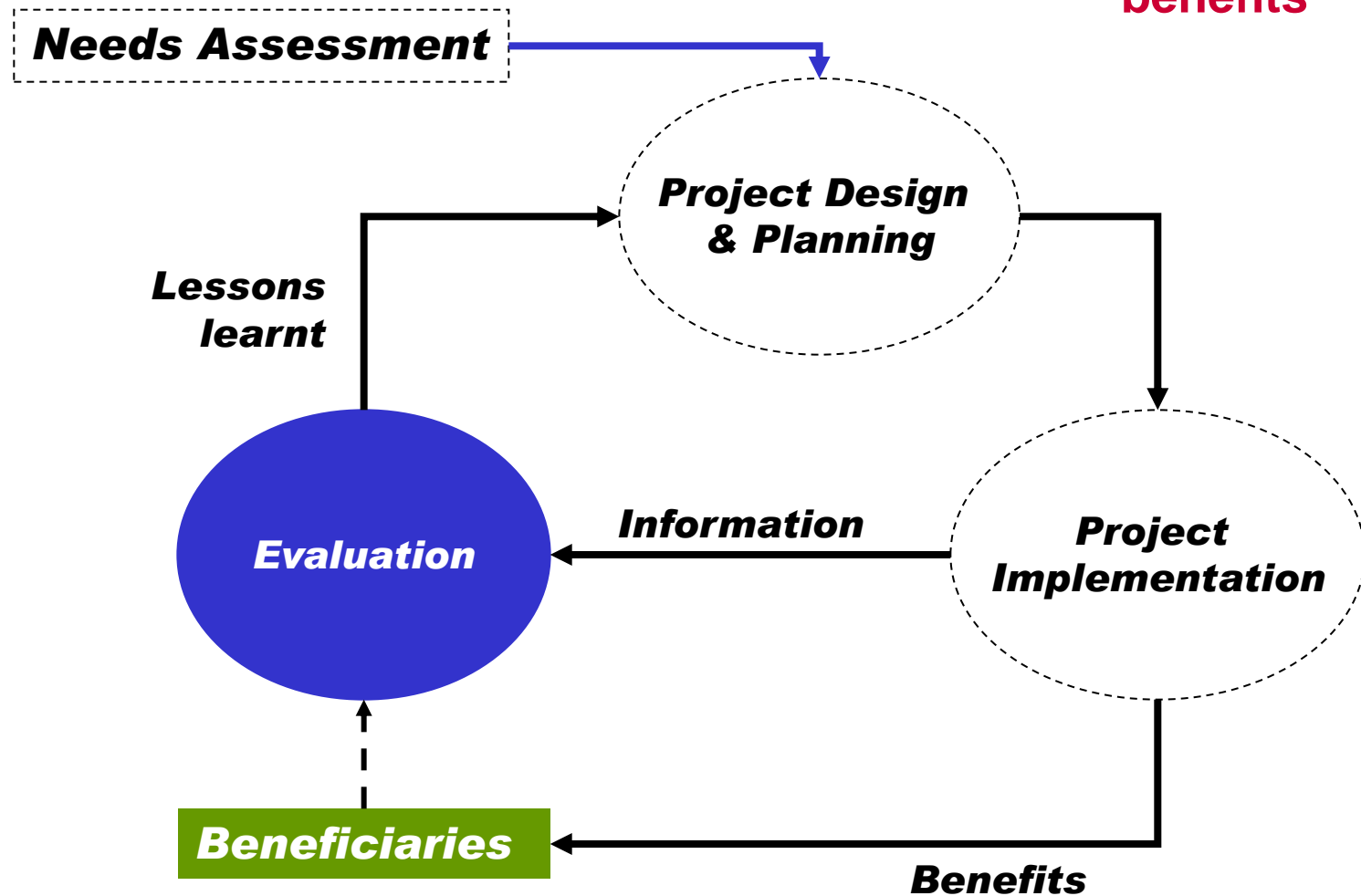


- > During implementation, ensure the project is delivering needed benefits



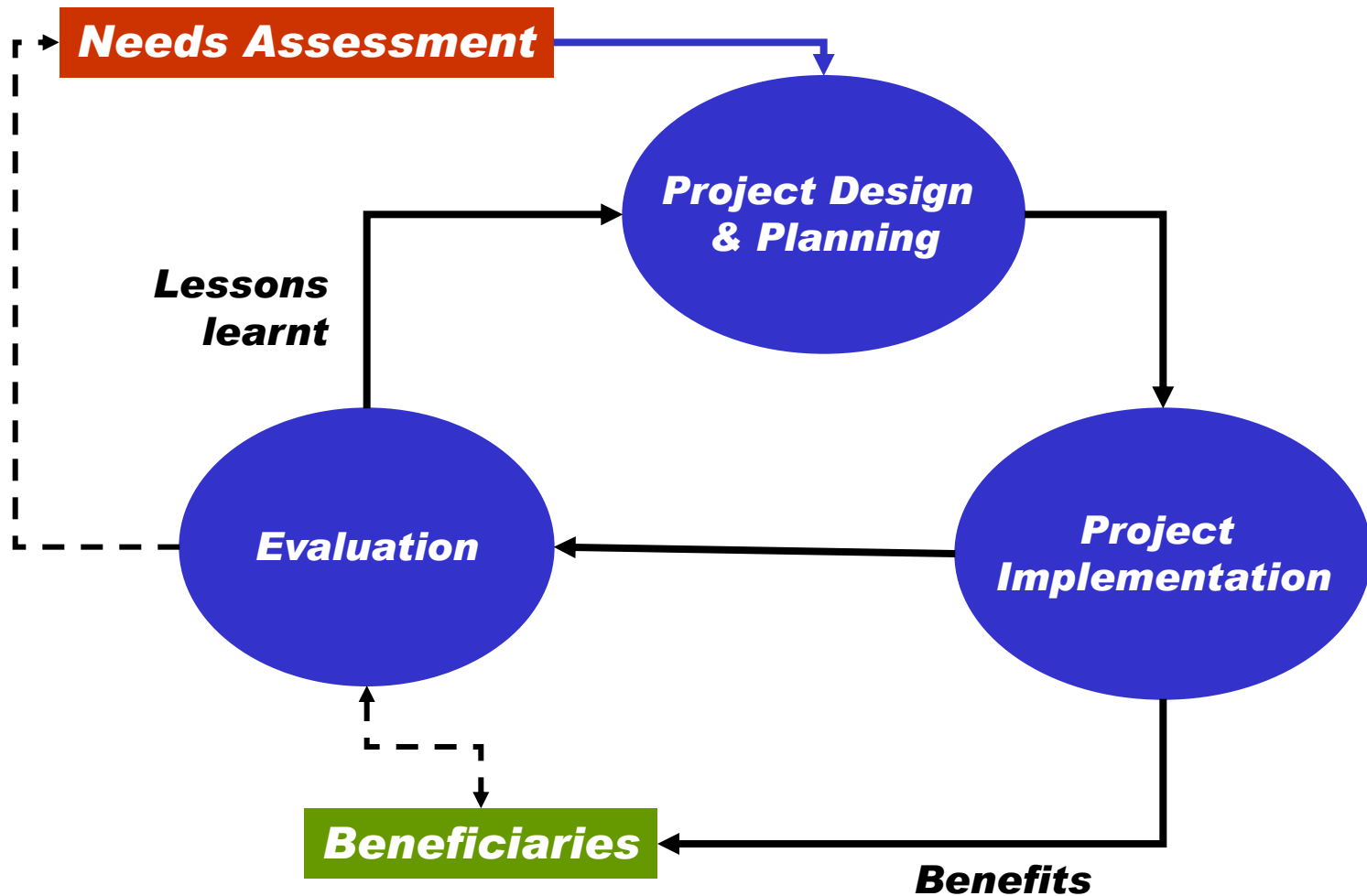


> Keep evaluating performance in terms of delivering benefits



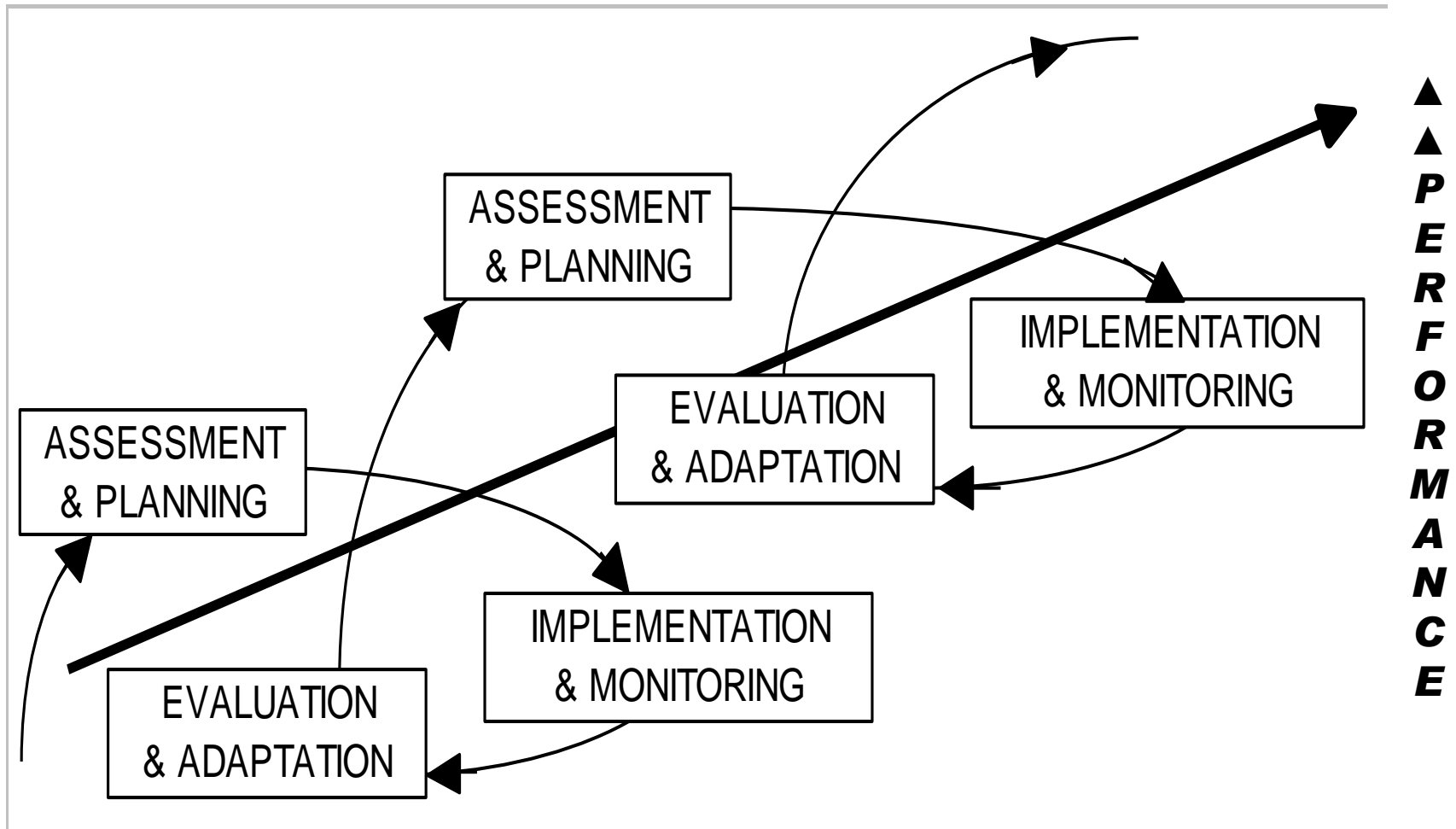


> Apply the lessons to the next generation project



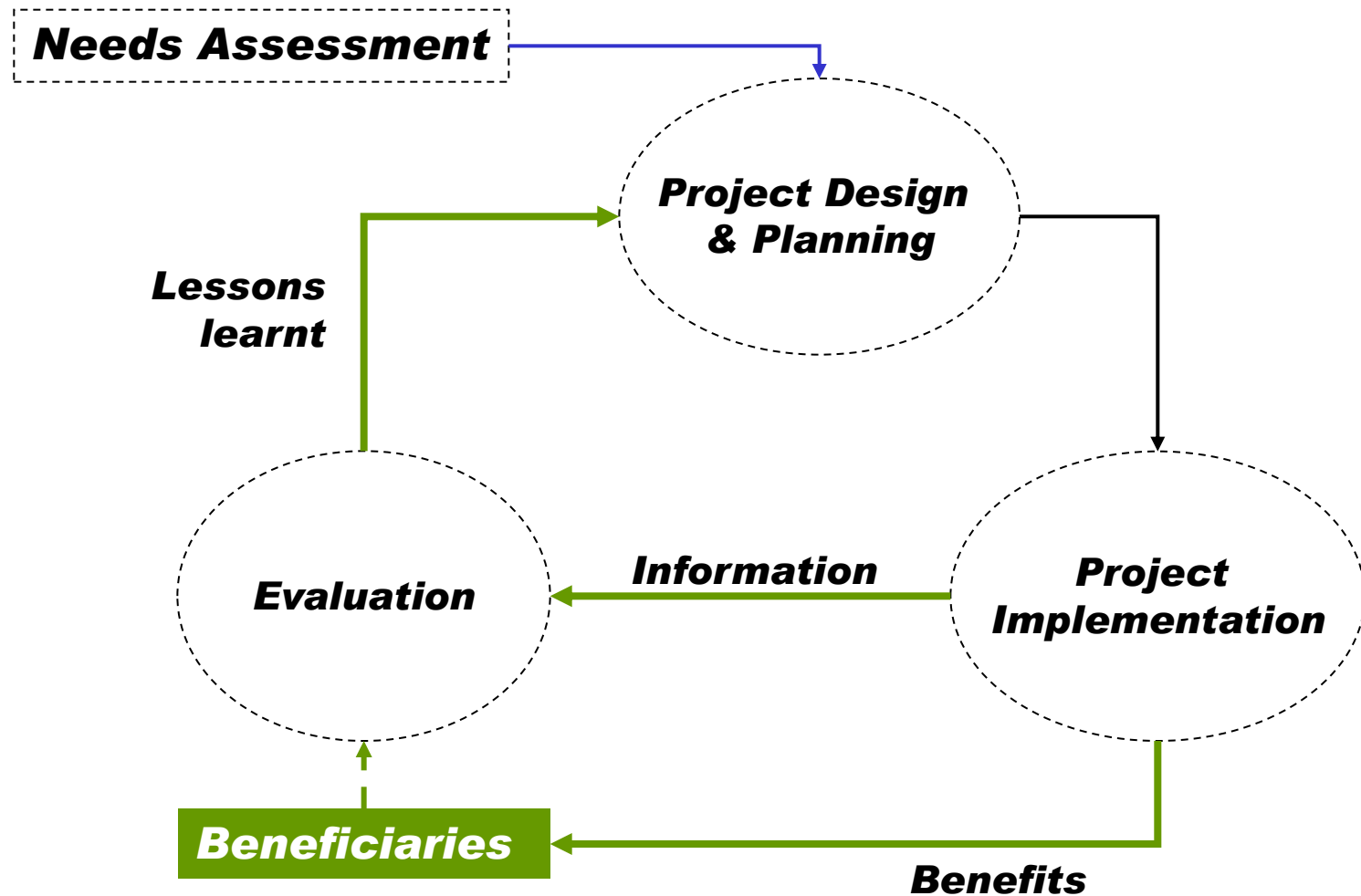


## > Performance improvement over time...



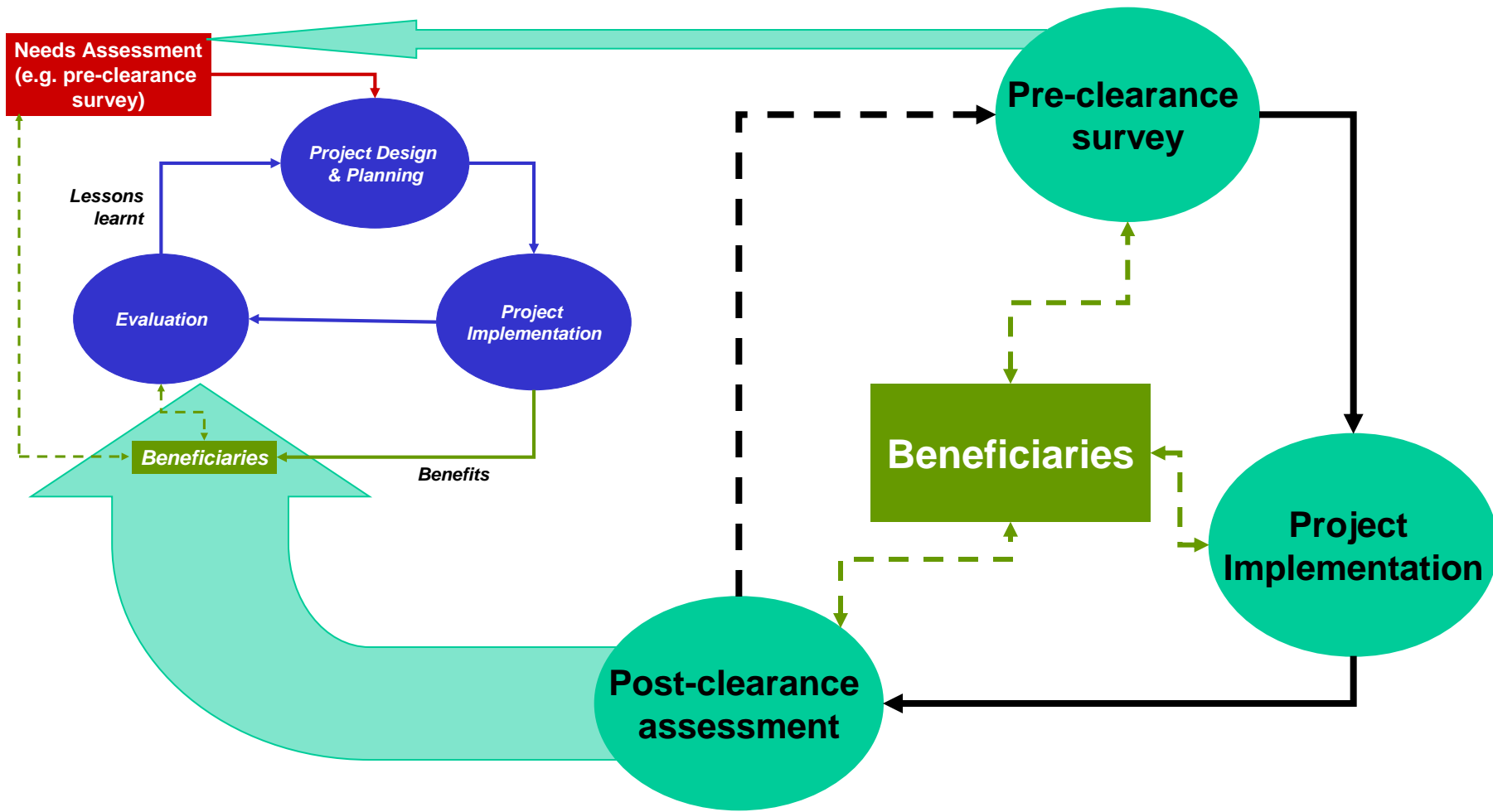


## > Two types of benefits from every project
