The Ammunition Management Advisory Team (AMAT) of Geneva International Centre for Humanitarian Demining (GICHD) is searching for an expert in the field of CONFORMITY ASSESSMENT SYSTEMS or the DEVELOPMENT OF INTERNATIONAL STANDARDS to support in the implementation of the [EU Council Decision 2020/979](#). AMAT is pleased to invite consultants to submit a quotation for the provision of the services described below as per requirements set out in this request for offers.

Scope of work

Established in 2019, the Ammunition Management Advisory Team (AMAT) is a joint initiative of the Geneva International Centre for Humanitarian Demining (GICHD) and the United Nations Office for Disarmament Affairs (UNODA). AMAT provides technical support to States in the safe, secure and effective management of ammunition in line with international best practice. Also, AMAT works to strengthen the capacities of States to improve the safety and security of ammunition stockpiles this contributing to a global reduction of the risks of accidental explosions and diversion.

AMAT wishes to engage an expert in establishing CONFORMITY ASSESSMENT SYSTEMS or other complex international initiatives. The consultant will serve as a strategic advisor and support a new effort to develop an internationally recognised conformity assessment system for the management of arms and ammunition. The project, which is implementing Phase 2 of the European Union Council Decision CFSP 2020/979, will create a framework for a conformity assessment system designed to provide stakeholders with assurances of national efforts to implement safe and secure arms and ammunition management practices. This system, known

as the Arms and Ammunition Management Validation System (AAMVS) intends to support efforts to reduce the risks of illicit arms proliferation and accidental explosions at storage facilities.

Phase 1 of the project (October 2020-November 2021) studied the feasibility of creating an Arms and Ammunition Management Validation System based on criteria set by the European Union (EU). The analysis determined that the AAMVS was feasible and that the system could be developed through a process of building international consensus. In Phase 2, AMAT will create the basic framework of the AAMVS (including the conformity assessment schemes for arms and ammunition management practices and a scheme ownership model) as well as a strategic plan for developing the system.

The purpose of this mandate is to provide AMAT and its partners with expert advice on aspects related to the development of an internationally recognised conformity assessment scheme. The consultant will support the development of critical elements of the AAMVS framework and advise on the processes and direction for developing broad international support for the system.

The Consultant will work closely with the AMAT project team technical and thematic specialists, and key stakeholders to advise on the establishment establish core features of the AAMVS. They will help facilitate meetings with key stakeholders and will advise the project team on aspects related to the development of conformity assessment systems. The Consultant will also advise on the formation of the AAMVS scheme manager/owner and will support technical experts in the development of the conformity assessment system. Other activities may include, depending on availability, presenting elements of the project at different international arms control events and gatherings. Travel to Geneva and internationally may be requested, depending on COVID restrictions.

The ideal candidate will have 10+ years of experience in conformity assessments, including operation and development of schemes. The consultant should have experience providing advice on the technical elements of a conformity assessment scheme or on the processes required to build consensus around a system. Experience in ISO Committee on conformity assessment (ISO/CASCO) or IEC Standardization Management Board (IEC/SMB) or in the development of independent conformity assessments would be beneficial.

To fulfil the tasks and roles for this position, the activities undertaken for this contract between 1 March – 30 November 2022 are expected to require an average of 2-4 days per month. Specifically, the consultant will be expected to:

1. Participate in and facilitate certain discussions during multiple planning and technical meetings with team members and key stakeholders;
2. Support technical experts in the development of the AAMVS conformity assessment, consistent with ISO/IEC 17000 series
3. Advise on potential frameworks for the AAMVS system owner.
4. Assist the team in developing a strategy to build international consensus around the AAMVS concept.
5. Present on technical aspects regarding conformity assessments (both generically, such as ISO/IEC 17000 series or specifically related to the AAMVS) to key stakeholders, including the European Union. Travel may be included, when possible.
