#### Why it Matters

- Global context: Over a third of countries worldwide remain contaminated by landmines, cluster
  munitions, and other explosive remnants a problem larger than any point since World War II
  and still growing.
- Innovation investment: While billions are invested globally in tech and innovation annually, similar attention must be devoted to lifesaving work in mine action

### From Technology Workshops to Innovation Conferences

- 2016–2022: Mine Action Technology Workshops connecting good practices, tools & methods
- **2023:** First GICHD Innovation Conference in Geneva broadened focus to processes, collaborations, and cross-sector innovation
- **2025:** Second Innovation Conference in Luxembourg expanding participatory formats, high-level engagement, and global collaboration
