Requirements

Specification of Services	<p>The consultant will provide expert technical services in ammunition management in Peru, supporting the Ammunition Management Advisory Team (AMAT) of the GICHD in reducing risks associated with unsafe or insecurely managed ammunition. This includes contributing to national capacity development through a Training-of-Trainers (ToT) programme for the Peruvian Armed Forces, working closely with newly trained instructors to mentor and advise them on preparing and delivering courses on the International Ammunition Technical Guidelines (IATG), conducting mentored assessments of ammunition storage areas, and providing advisory support on safety and security measures. The consultant will also assist national authorities in implementing and institutionalizing good practices and standards for safe and secure ammunition management. In addition, the consultant will support the organization and facilitation of strategic-level conferences, liaise with national authorities and regional stakeholders, represent AMAT-GICHD in relevant meetings, and provide logistical and technical support for field missions, including through the UN SaferGuard Quick Response Mechanism.</p>
Timing	<p>The services are expected to be provided over a two and a half-year period, from July 2026 to December 2028, contingent upon the availability of secured funding for the duration of the assignment.</p>
Terms	<p>Suppliers must agree to comply with GICHD's Partner Code of Conduct, the GICHD General Terms and Conditions (subject only to commercial negotiations), and any donor-mandated compliance clauses.</p>
Place of assignment	<p>The consultant will be based in Lima, with potential travel requirements to other Latin American countries and to Geneva as needed.</p>
